


We sincerely request all stakeholders to go through it. We also look forward to your valuable feedback. This will certainly help improve our focus and efforts in our pursuit of excellence.







Students and staff of RVU offer tributes to the late Chancellor and President Emeritus, RSST Dr. M.K. Panduranga Setty

Following the demise of Chancellor and President Emeritus, RSST, Dr. M.K. Panduranga Setty, the RVU family came together and offered floral tributes at a prayer meeting held on 24 January 2023. Studens and staff paid heartfelt tributes to Dr. Setty. He steered the RSST for nearly five decades and helped establish 22 top-quality academic institutions in Bangalore in which over 20,000 students are currently enrolled. He was conferred the Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Memorial Award in 2016 by the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FKCCI), Karnataka Rajyotsava Award and many other awards.





Mr. Chivikula passionately spoke on the topic, providing several examples and insights from his illustrious career.





SoLAS conducted a weekend workshop on Film Appreciation Course: Appreciating cinema





Campus Bird Count activity at RVU


