Bar Council of India (BCI) accords recognition to School of Law (SoL) at RV University (RVU)

Legal education regulator, Bar Council of India has approved the RV University's School of Law and its 5-year integrated B.A. LL.B. and B.B.A. LL.B. programmes, vide letter dated 23 June 2023. The School of Law (SoL) degree programmes will commence from August 2023. Our School of Law will offer a range of programmes designed to equip students with the knowledge, skills, and ethical values necessary to excel in the legal field.

Additionally, in partnership with Seattle University, USA, RV University's SoL has designed two joint programmes. Under the first programme, students will be offered the opportunity to pursue LL.M. pathway, a dual-degree programme. Students enrolled in the five-year integrated law programme will have the chance to obtain an undergraduate degree in law from RVU and an LL.M. degree from Seattle School of Law in their chosen area of specialization within a span of five years. The second programme provides an LL.M. student with the opportunity to pursue a second LL.M. degree from Seattle University. Furthermore, Seattle University will offer a 50% tuition scholarship for five students. At the end of two years, the student can get two LL.M. degrees, from both RV University and Seattle University.

Students can enroll for five-year integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) or B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons.), LL.M and Ph.D.. The admissions for undergraduate, postgraduate and full-time/ part-time Ph.D. programmes are already underway.



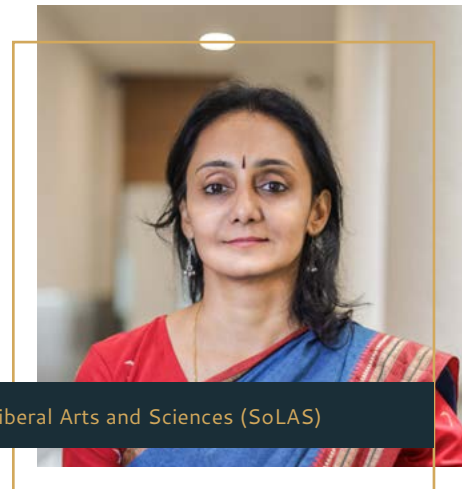
Major leadership changes at RVU

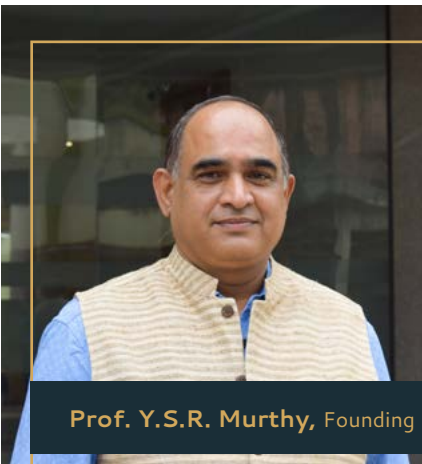
Dr. Anuradha Chatterjee, Dean, School of Design and Innovation (SDI)

We are delighted to share that the team comprising RV College of Architecture and School of Design and Innovation (SDI), RV University emerged as winners at the Solar Decathlon India in the 'Educational Building' Category. The event was held at Infosys Campus, Mysore between May 25 – 27, 2023. Ms. Dhatri, a second year student of B.Des. (Spatial Design and Interior Design) was part of the winning team.

Ms. Megha Parthasarathy, 2nd year B.Des, Ms. Yashica and Mr. Nikhil Dayanand also participated in the competition. Every year, this competition is jointly organised by the Indian Institute for Human Settlements (IIHS) and the Alliance for an Energy-Efficient Economy (AEEE) under the aegis of the Indo-US Science and Technology Forum (IUSSTF).

This nine-months long competition has students compete in six divisions and propose building projects which are designed keeping in view the Net-Zero Challenge. The jury evaluates the building projects on the basis of innovative elements, affordability, practicality and marketability. In addition to the academic institutions, 30 organisations participated in the challenge this year in partnership with student teams. 1780 students from 120+ institutions across the country participated out of which only 36 were given the opportunity to present their designs before the eminent jury comprising leaders from the real estate and media industry.

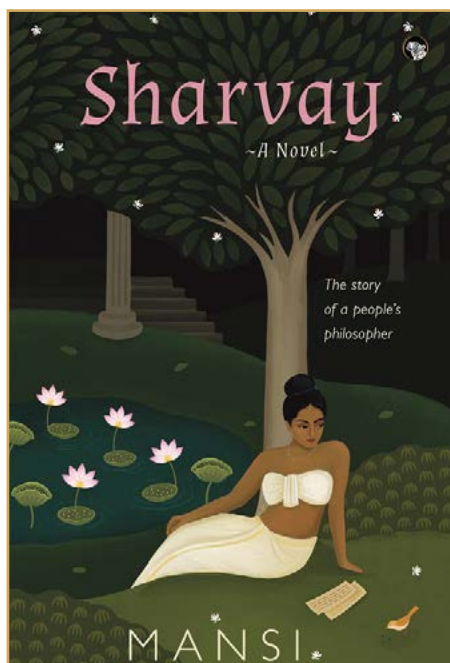

Faculty achievements

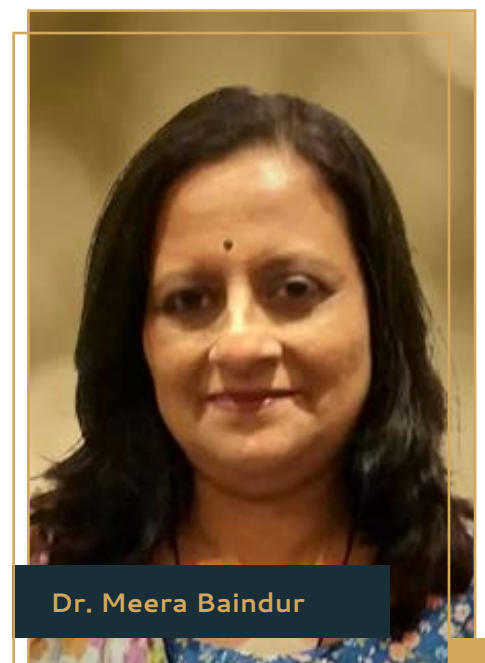


Dr. Meera Baidur, Associate Professor, School of Liberal Arts and Sciences (SoLAS) led the Indian delegation for the International Philosophy Olympiads (IPO) held at Greece this year in May. After a gap of a few years, the Indian delegation to the 31st IPO was resumed. This year's theme for the Olympiad was *A life in fair competition*. Dr. Baidur conducted a national level test in April and two candidates were selected, based on the essays submitted in the competition – Meet Srijariya (Delhi) and Nandkishore (Bangalore).

The International Philosophy Olympiads, a competition for high-school pupils, first took place in 1993, by an initiative of the Department of Philosophy of Sofia University to invite a group of philosophers from various countries. Since 2001 the International Philosophy Olympiads have been organized under the auspices of FISP and with the recognition and support of UNESCO. The member countries participating in IPO, held every year in May, require a commitment on the part of the national delegations to promote the study of Philosophy in their home country and to organize a national competition in Philosophy.

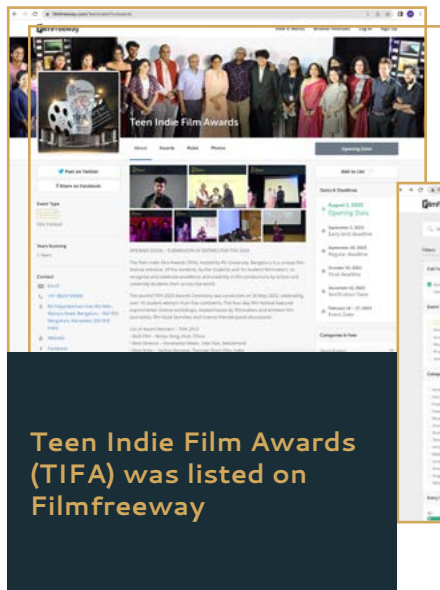

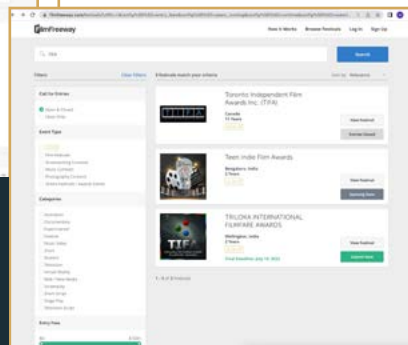

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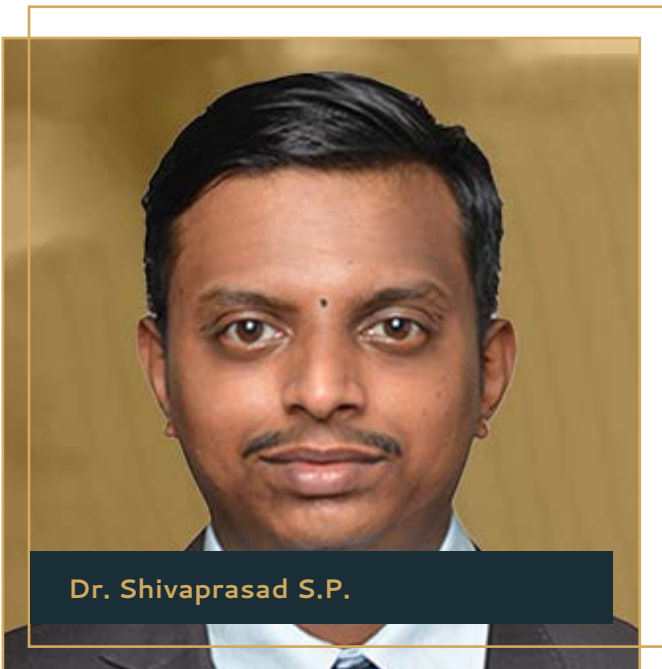

Reformation of Maintenance Laws- 30 May 2023



RV University organised a panel discussion on Maintenance Laws in partnership with Vasavya Mahila Mandali with the objective to sensitise the different stakeholders around maintenance laws in India while also discussing possible solutions to the surrounding issues. Maintenance is a legal right that ensures women (and children) have access to financial support (not excluding provision for food, clothing, residence, medical expenses, treatment, etc) after a legal divorce.



The panel underscored the need to see maintenance as a human rights issue and the need for the State to do its part to fulfil women's rights. The panel also emphasised the need to expand the definition of maintenance from the current sustenance levels to ensure a dignified livelihood.

40 teams of students participated in the Engineering Make-a-thon



The School of Computer Science and Engineering (SoCSE) organised an Engineering Make-a-thon to bring teams of students to work together to make (build) engineering solutions for specific problems. This involved hardware and software integration, often including mechanical, electrical and electronics components. During this two-day event, 40 teams of students were given hands-on mentoring by other senior students, faculty as well as industry subject matter experts. On the third day, the teams presented their prototypes or solutions to a panel of judges comprising internal and external faculty and experts. Students explained their design choices, demonstrated the functionality of their prototypes, and highlighted the potential impact or value of their solutions.

Make-a-thon – 31 May 2023

Judges evaluated the projects based on various criteria, such as innovation, technical depth, creativity and clarity in presentation and potential for real-world implementation. Some of their makings included building solutions for depression detection using brain activity and heart rate sensors, license number plate recognition so that visitors' vehicles can be differentiated from employees', home automation, smart city, robotic medicine delivery to patients hospitalized, assembling an open source 3D printer which will help students to understand abstract concepts by building physical objects for easy visualization, smart drip irrigation, mobile robots, gesture recognition for gaming with AR-VR headset etc. The student mentors from RVCE and the subject matter expert mentors from the industry, along with the in-house faculty mentors were instrumental in the successful completion of the projects. The student participants were very thankful to the mentors and the management, for the opportunity they got in their very second semester to apply their knowledge and develop integrated engineering skills.



IEEE CCEM 2023 – 10 June 2023



The Prelude to the Twelfth IEEE International Conference on Cloud Computing in Emerging Markets (CCEM), held on 12 June 2023, was in collaboration with the School of Computer Science and Engineering (SoCSE). The format of this prelude was a unique concept – ‘Pre-Conference Workshop’ which had two broad tracks. One was a mentoring workshop track for students or budding researchers who have a seed of an idea and want to build on it to convert to a proof of concept, product or research paper. The second was an invited talk track which brought together top-notch researchers, talks from industry and government leaders, ideas for innovative projects, and startup proposals. The conference provided a platform for researchers, professionals, and entrepreneurs to exchange ideas, discuss the latest advancements, and explore the challenges and opportunities presented by cloud computing.
