In February 2024, Dr. Uniyal's poems were featured on Hindawi, a renowned literary platform curated by the Rekhta Foundation (Urdu).



"Digital Pedagogy in Design Education" (DPDE) '24 symposium hosted by SDI - 27-28 March 2024




