







Know your Dean

Former Editor of popular film magazine, Stardust and film-weekly, StarWeek, he has worked at senior reporting positions in leading Indian dailies (The Indian Express, Hindustan Times), the Society magazine, and has been published in The Times of India Crest Edition, The Asian Age, Screen and The New Indian Express, authoring over 1000 media publications. He's been the writer of three popular film columns, 'Sunday Talkies' with Orissa Post (2011–2018), 'Soul Cinema' with The Times of India Speaking Tree (2018–) edition, and 'Friday Talkies' with The Hindu (2021–).

Author of five books, two fiction - Never Say Never Again (2007) and Alexander: An Epic Love Story (2007), one poetry (all heats Dusted, 2021) and an online novel series, The Millennium Batch (2020); in 2019, he made his non-fiction and feature film debut with Bollywood FAQ: All That's Left to Know About the Greatest Film Story Never Told (Rowman & Littlefield Publishing Group, USA), and a critically acclaimed documentary, Pleasures Prejudice & Pride: An Indian Way of Filmmaking. It was the first 21st century Indian documentary to be the focus of a multi-city global seminar screening tour, across seven universities in the United Kingdom in September-October 2019. His latest book, Appreciating Melodrama: Theory and Practice in Indian Cinema and Television (Bloomsbury 2022) argues for a review of Indian cinema using Indian aesthetic philosophies, and latest documentary, The Monarch of the Blue Mountain (2024), explores the timeless, universal appeals of Sri Jagannath culture and consciousness. Honoured with "Special Mention" for Best Critic at the 60th Indian National Film Awards (2013) by the President of India, Pranab Mukherjee, he was invited by Queen Elizabeth II and The Duke of Edinburgh to the UK-India Year of Culture's official inauguration at the Buckingham Palace on 27 February 2017 featuring eminent Indians from the nation's civil society, politics, sports, arts, culture and media.



Know your Faculty

Rahul Jayaram is a triple postgraduate with degrees from three continents: History from Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) in New Delhi; Literature from Edinburgh University, and Journalism from Columbia University. He was a founding faculty at the Jindal School of Liberal Arts & Humanities at the O P Jindal Global University, arguably India's first liberal arts undergraduate programme, and later was the founding faculty at Vidyashilp University in Bangalore. He has worked as a journalist in Mumbai, Muscat, Bangalore and Delhi for a decade, and his reportage, feature writing, opinion pieces and long-form reportage or essays have appeared in almost every Indian paper, magazine or website of record in English, and some in the Britain, America, Pakistan, Oman and the United Arab Emirates. His creative work was long-listed for the Commonwealth Short Story Prize in 2023, for the Juggernaut Short Story Prize in 2018, and won the Jury Prize at the Tata Literature Festival in Mumbai in 2023. He is a previous winner of the National Scholarship at JNU(2000–2002), the Commonwealth Scholarship at Edinburgh University (2004–2005) and the International Fellows Program at Columbia University (2011–2012) and was a runner-up for the Harris Prize for best student thesis at Columbia Journalism School in 2012. He was awarded for teaching at the O P Jindal Global University in 2016.


