


Message from the Vice Chancellor



RVU welcomed over 2,300 students at Navodaya 2025



RVU hosted its fifth annual Navodaya 2025 celebrations, inducting over 2,300 students into its nine schools offering undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. With this intake, the University's total student strength has crossed 6,000.


RVU held its 3rd Annual Convocation: 259 students graduated across six streams



RVU held its third annual convocation on 30 August 2025. A total of 259 students graduated in six streams with nine receiving honours for exceptional academic performance. The event was graced by Sri Kailash Satyarthi, Nobel Peace Laureate (2014), internationally acclaimed child rights activist, and founder of Bachpan Bachao Andolan, who delivered the Convocation Address.

He has held senior faculty and administrative roles at premier institutions such as XLRI Jamshedpur, IIM Kozhikode, and IIM Raipur, where he served as Director from 2022 to 2025. His teaching portfolio also includes a distinguished stint at LBSNAA Mussoorie, where he groomed future civil servants of India. Internationally, Prof. Kakani has taught and collaborated with institutions in Denmark, Nigeria, Singapore, and the UAE.




SoCSE organised a programme on "Emerging Trends in Big Data and Data Science"

Khan and Ms. Sandhyashree Ms. Rafa Karanth, third-year students of the School of Law (SoL) and members of the Centre for Criminal Justice Studies, presented their paper "Evidence in the Age of Algorithms: A Legal Analysis under the Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam" at the 2nd International Conference on Global Criminology and Victimology, 2025. Their research combined legal analysis with a sociological lens, drawing on ideas of Michael Foucault's theories to examine how Al-generated evidence can shape power, surveillance, and behaviour. They highlighted concerns around transparency, bias, privacy, and fair trial rights.

On 24 July 2025, our students from SoB and SDI respectively, Mr. Arya Sujay (President) and Ms. Charitha Rao (Vice President) of the Under 25 Club represented the University at the Under 25 Bootcamp 2025 in Mumbai. The event brought together the top 100 student leaders from across India to celebrate impactful campus initiatives. RVU was nominated in five categories and won three — Best Club, Most Impactful Community and Vice Fellow of the Year reflecting the creativity, leadership, and spirit of our student community.









Faculty and staff Achievements



Prof. Shobha G., Dean of the School of Computer Science and Engineering (SoCSE), delivered an outstanding presentation on "Massively Scalable Density-Based Clustering (DBSCAN) on the HPCC Systems Big Data Platform" at the International Conference on Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning in Copenhagen, Denmark. The Mindspace Conferences & Organising Committee recognised her contribution as highly impactful and noteworthy.

Prof. Arindam Mitra, Dean of the School of Allied and Healthcare Professions (SoAHP), has had a remarkable series of achievements in 2025. In July, he participated in the "Addressing Challenges in Teaching" workshop organised by the National Institute on Scientific Teaching (NIST), focusing on alternative grading strategies and inclusive, evidence-based teaching practices. On 3rd July, he edited an article published in Frontiers in Cellular and Infection Microbiology on the prognostic and diagnostic significance of inflammatory markers in diabetic foot infections. Shortly after, on 10 July, he joined the Advisory Council meeting of the Microbiology Society, UK, in London contributing to discussions on scientific priorities, policy, diversity, and international collaboration. Dr. Mitra has been elected as an Advisory Council member with a term from 2025-27.



In September, Prof. Mitra attended BIOME 2025, a US-based National Faculty Development Program, receiving a USD 1,000 scholarship and publishing his presentation as a featured Open Education Resource.

He also co-authored his third open-access Scopus-indexed paper this year in The Microbe, exploring the brain-eating amoeba Naegleria fowleri and its role in Primary Amebic Meningoencephalitis (PAM), raising critical awareness for public health.



Prof. Ranjini C. R., Professor of Public Policy, School of Economics and Public Policy (SoEPP) was awarded the Silver Prize in the 2025 Teaching Public Service in the Digital Age (TPSDA) Global Case Study Competition, an initiative founded at the Harvard Kennedy School.

Her case study, "India's Open Digital Health Ecosystem: A Case Study of the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission," was selected as one of only 12 shortlisted entries from over 300 global submissions, and notably, the only winning entry from India. The competition celebrates innovative teaching approaches that prepare public servants for the challenges of digital-era governance.

Prof. Dwarika Prasad Uniyal, Pro Vice Chancellor and Dean of the School of Business, School of Economics and Public Policy, and School for Continuing Education and Professional Studies, delivered a lecture on "Leadership and Crisis Management" at the Indian Railways Institute of Disaster Management on 10 July 2025 and later moderated a panel discussion at the Outdoor Asia Convention (OAC) 2025 in Mumbai (18–19 July 2025) on the theme "Is the Future of OOH an Al Prompt Away?"

He subsequently attended Resonomics at Conrad Bengaluru, engaging with keynote speaker Shri Ram Madhavji and senior industry leaders, and met Mr. Udai Raina, Business Leader, B2B at Reliance Jio, to explore internship opportunities for RVU students. On 25 September 2025, Prof. Uniyal participated as a panellist at an event organised by D2L, where he spoke on "Technology and the Future of Quality Assurance in Indian Higher Education."







Mr. Shantanu Pachauri, Assistant Professor at the School of Law (SoL), has authored an insightful article titled "Narco-Analysis and Procedural Abuse in Bail Proceedings in India", published by the Oxford Human Rights Hub. This was published on 14 July 2025.

On 11 September 2025, Dr. Abhishek Chatterjee, Assistant Professor at the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences (SoLAS), participated in a panel discussion at Vidyashilp Academy on `Liberal Education in India.' The session explored fresh perspectives and real-world experiences to drive innovation and excellence in liberal arts learning.





Dr. Bhanu Prakash Nunna, Assistant Professor and Director, Centre for Victimological Research and Victim Assistance (CVRVA) at SoL, has been elected as the Secretary-General of the World Society of Victimology (WSV), becoming only the second Indian ever to hold this prestigious position.

In this global leadership role, Dr. Nunna will steer international advocacy, research, and policy on victim rights, representing WSV at the United Nations and other global platforms, while also shaping the 2027 International Symposium on Victimology in Montreal, Canada.

Prof. Ram Kumar Kakani, Vice Chancellor of RVU, served as the keynote speaker and trainer at the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA), Mussoorie, during the Training for Trainers on Basic Leadership Module held on 15 and 16 September 2025.

He also delivered a keynote address on "Leading in an Interdisciplinary World" at IIT Delhi on 21 September 2025. Additionally, he presented a special invited lecture at the Central University of Rajasthan, Kishangarh, on "Leadership as Legacy: Building Institutions with Soul" on 24 September 2025.








79th Independence Day celebration at RV University



RVU, in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) – Karnataka Regional Branch, hosted a one-day conference on 'Reducing Maternal Mortality in Karnataka' at the MineRVa Auditorium, RV Centre for Leadership & Executive Education, Bengaluru.

The conference brought together policymakers, public health experts, and medical professionals to deliberate on the factors contributing to Karnataka's maternal mortality ratio (MMR) of 68 per 100,000 live births, higher than most neighbouring states and to identify actionable strategies for improvement.




National Librarians' Day celebration at RVU

Partnerships and Collaborations



On 29 July 2025, the School of Computer Science and Engineering (SoCSE) has signed an MoU with Garuda Aerospace Private Limited, Chennai, to foster education, research, and innovation in drone technology, UAVs, and aerospace applications. The collaboration will enable specialised training programmes, workshops,

The collaboration will enable specialised training programmes, workshops, internships, and R&D initiatives, along with the establishment of a UAV Data Analytics Lab. This partnership marks a key step in strengthening academia—industry collaboration and advancing national priorities in aerospace and robotics.

SoCSE signed an MoU with Frontier Business Systems Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore, to establish customised Cloud Labs across AWS, GCP, and Azure platforms for the academic year 2025–2026. This MoU was signed on 30 July 2025. These labs, aligned with the SoCSE curriculum, will offer students handson learning experiences in cloud computing, enhancing their technical placement readiness, skills, potential for professional certifications. This collaboration reflects RVU's commitment to academic-industry partnerships and advancing skilling and innovation in cloud technologies.





SoCSE signed an MoU with the Indo Universal Collaboration for Engineering Education (IUCEE) on 1 August 2025 to enhance teaching excellence and innovation in engineering education. Following the MoU, a workshop on "Student-Centric Teaching" was organised, led by Prof. Krishna Vedula, Founder and Executive Director of IUCEE. The session guided educators in adopting active learning, real-world problem-solving, and outcome-based teaching methods to foster engaging and dynamic classroom experiences.
